Who should attend?

- O Regular school teachers of preschool, nurseries & kindergartens elementary to high school, special needs teachers & educators, school head masters & principals.
- O OT's, speech & language therapists, psychologists, child caregivers, nuerodevelopment therapists, doctors, physiotherapists, etc.
- O Parents and caretakers of special needs children

Workshop Objectives?

This work shop is designed to help participants learn how to teach, educate & provide basic therapy & education & address the various difficulties and problems that special needs children face. through various strategies & activities including movement, exercise, play, games, music, songs, etc. This can be done on a one-to-one basis for one child or in a group setting, by teachers in a classroom or gym, parents in the living room of their own home & caregivers in their workplace.

What is this Workshop about?

This workshop will cover various topics that include the following....

- 1. Development & behavioral issues that are associated with Autism, PDD-NOS, Asperger's syndrome, physical & learning difficulties.
- The Senses & various Reflexes & how partially retained Primitive & under developed Postural Reflexes can affect learning & motor coordination. Considerations, providing strategies & various therapies for educating & supporting special needs children as mentioned in point 1.
- How Early Intervention especially between the ages of 1 to 6 years would help babies, toddlers & young children with developmental delays, disabilities, physical, social, communication & behavioral problems would really help put a child on the road to achieve a better & brighter future, a better quality of life & more independent living.
- 4. How to cope with & address various types of problematic behavior in children
- 5. How you could use a general screening tool for special needs children.
- 6. The 'Move to Learn' Program. How it will help support & promote primitive reflex integration & the development of postural reflexes in toddlers & young children. By doing it just 15 to 20 minutes a day with your child at home or in school it will improve the brain & body's balance, communication and coordination which makes for better learning.
- 7. The Cee Bee Center in Japan & the development of its 'ACE' Program (Activity, Communication and Exercise Program).
- 8. Various physical movements, activities, exercises, games and songs that will help raise a child's level of.....
 - o body awareness- o brain & body coordination o body center line balance-
 - o concentration -> o self-confidence -> o spatial awareness & spatial skills -> o behavior
 - o coordination & communication between the left and right sides of the brain-
 - o gross and fine motor skills-" o vestibular stimulation-" o body movement & rhythm-"
 - o social communication skills o proprioception o cognitive skills
